

**Description:**

In this simple introduction to fish and ecology, Melissa Stewart shares with young readers the behavior and beauty of fish and describes specific ways people can help protect them and their natural habitats. Children learn basic facts about fish, including where they live, what they eat, and how they benefit plants and other animals. Sidebars throughout the book contain information on human action that has harmed fish and on the many ways people can protect threatened fish populations. Pointers on how youngsters can help fish in their own community are also included.

Revisions include updated text, one new map, one new species and associated spread, and an updated bibliography.
