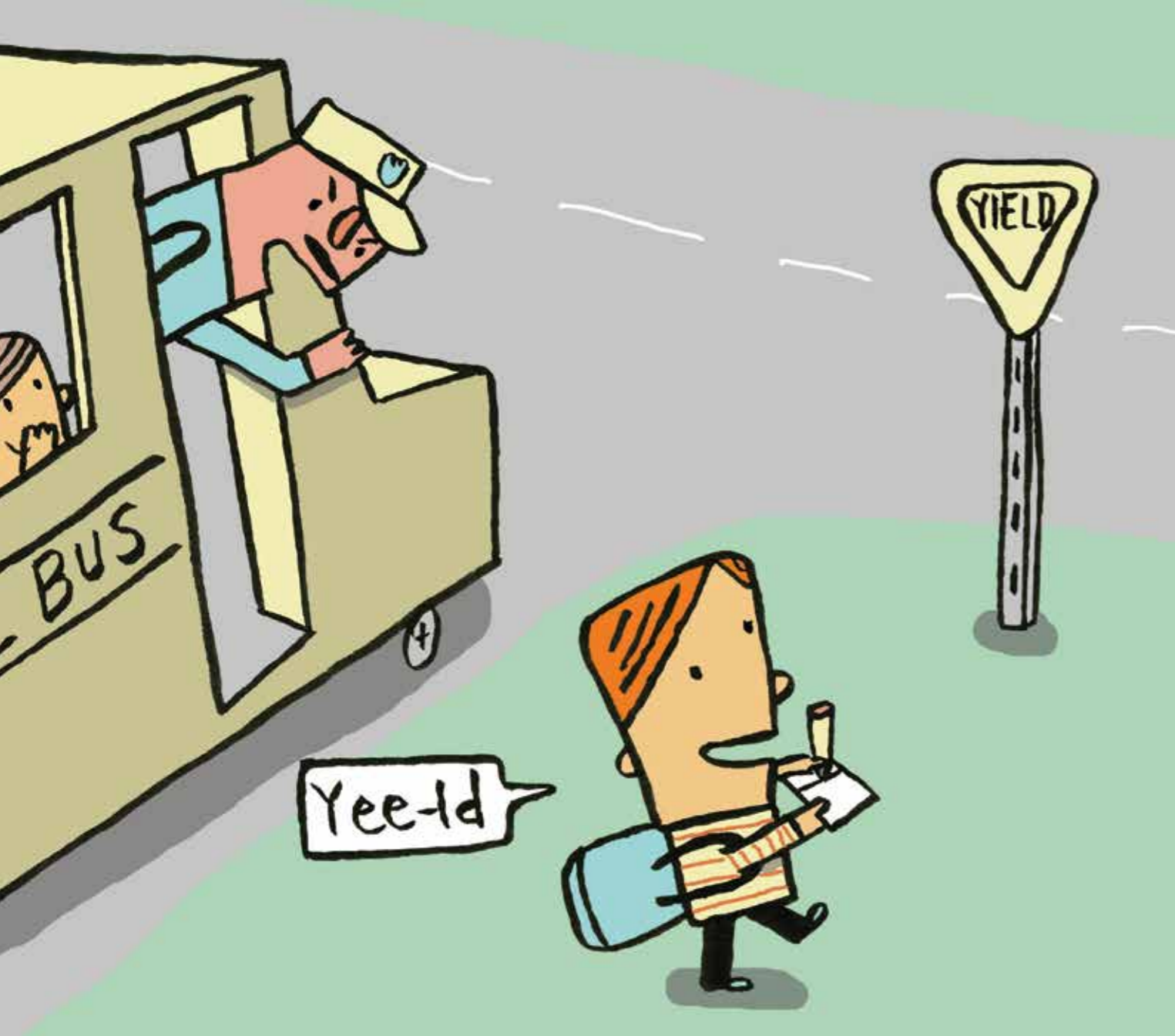
Ebenezer did not collect rocks.
